Jordan Company was awarded the Construction Manager at Risk Contract for UNCW's Allied Health Building, a 145,000 square foot Health Sciences facility that will house the new Health and Human Services College, the Center for Healthy Living, existing academic programs in Health and Applied Human Sciences and Social Work, support space for military-affiliated students, and related labs and classrooms critical to UNCW's ability to produce more health care professionals and expand services to the rural areas of the region.

Sites for the facility require specialized foundation work, the extension of all primary infrastructure services to the site, as well as a chiller replacement at the central plant.
